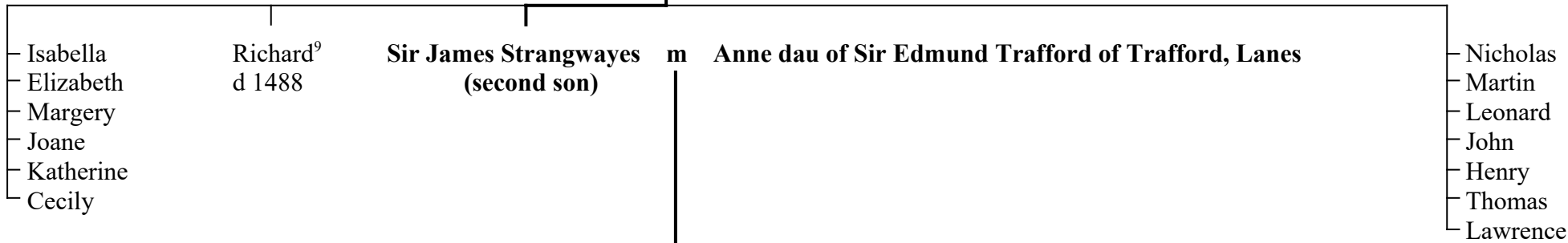

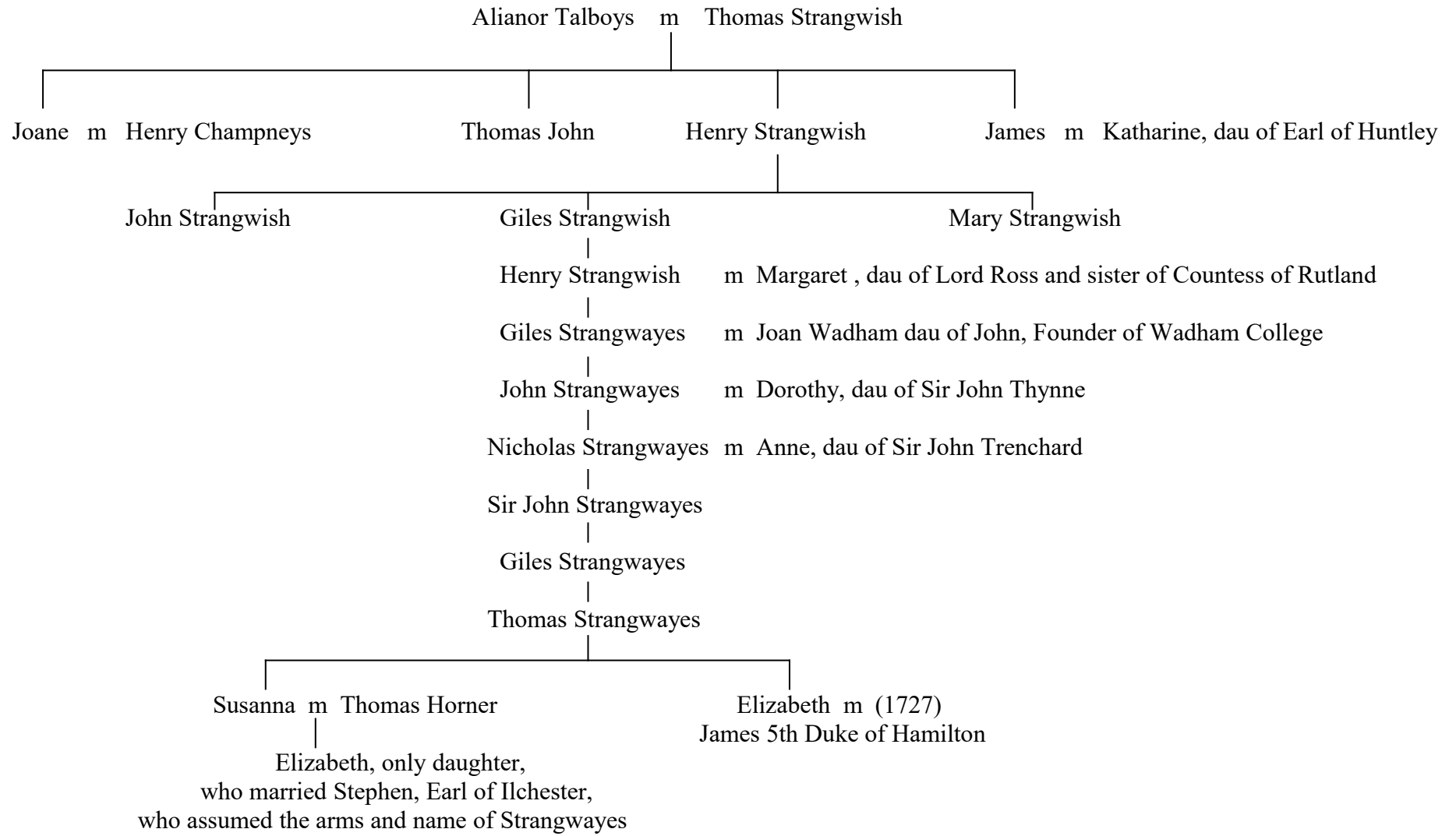
#### 4. THE NORMAN CONNECTION

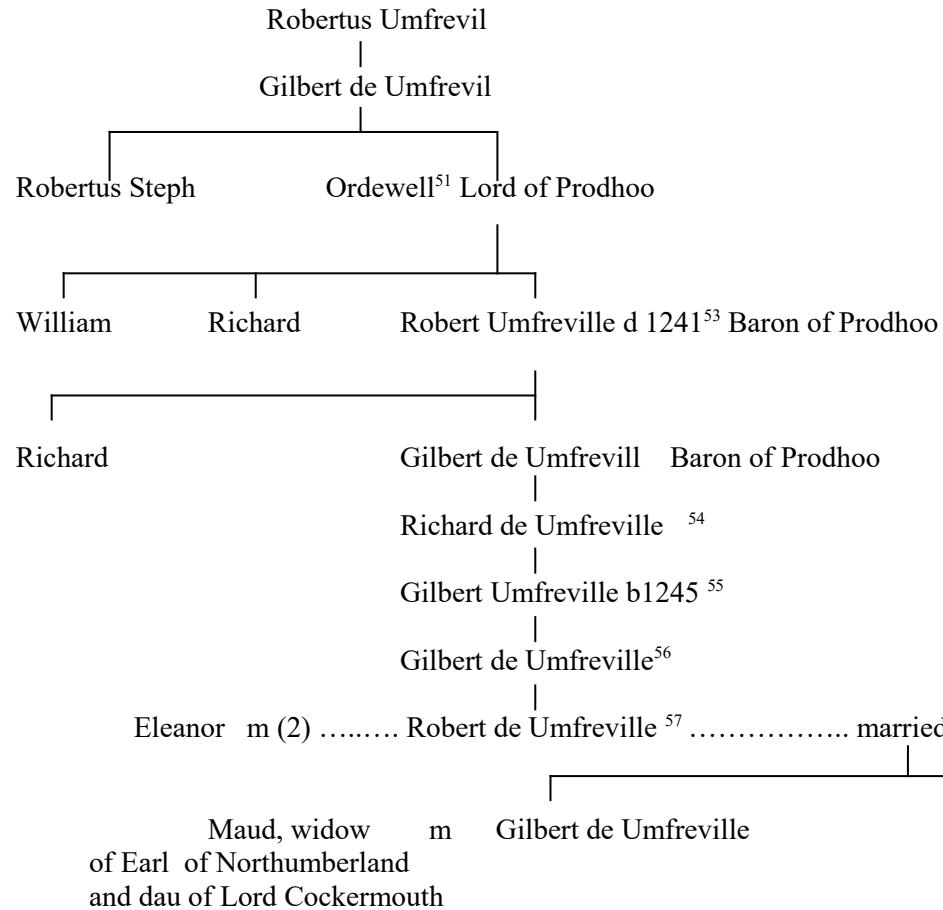

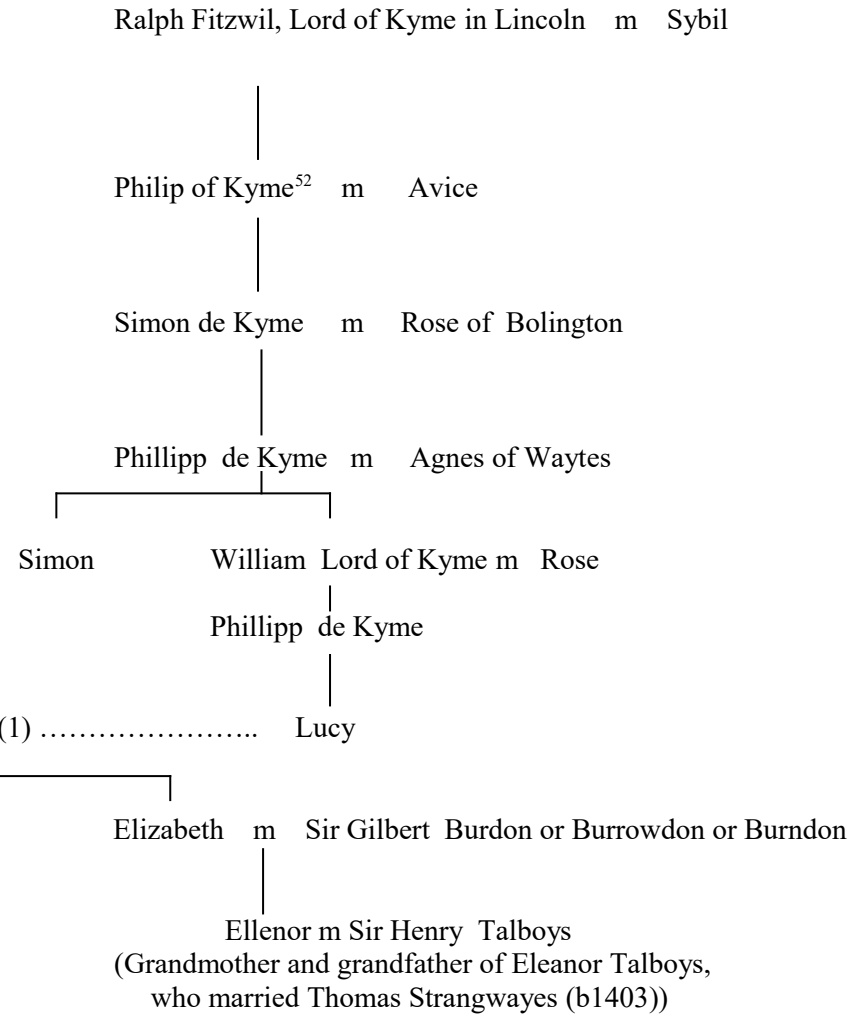
